Mountains of data are being collected but underutilized because farmers shoulder the burden of reformatting, organizing, uploading, storing, and transmitting it.



WHAT IS THE AG DATA COALITION?



A coalition of universities, industry, and agricultural service providers to support producers, facilitate dialog, and advance collaboration in the new era of data driven agriculture.



KEY NON-PROFIT PURPOSES



- Create a platform and related infrastructure for the collection of agricultural-related data and its use for non-commercial research and development with data owner permission;
- Conduct, support and facilitate collaborative data research and educational activities that benefit and enhance the use of agricultural data and its range of applications;
- Educate the agricultural industry and the public about the value of agricultural data and its impact or potential;
- Educate the agricultural industry about the operability of agronomic, machine and other agricultural-related data;



ORGANIZE

BENEFITS of CONTROL



- Farmers save time and money by having all their data in a single secure and transparent repository.
- A farm using ADC can permission and share data (for example yield maps) with one or more advisors for development of recommendations.
- Permissions can be provided for a specific file, folder, time interval or project, so that, upon completion of the project, the grower maintains full control of their important asset.
- A farm using ADC can revoke sharing or discontinue a sharing relationship, and have confidence that their data remains intact and under their control.

TRANSFER – Simple upload, smart upload direct from monitor USB, share, or connect to clouds – Raven, John Deere, Climate, CNH, and AGCO



ACCESS – Desktop, Mobile, Tablet...



SHARE - Trusted Advisors, Staff, Insurance Agent; whomever, whatever. File, folder, project, one or many people, even set an expiration date



THE ADC DIFFERENCE



FARMER CONTROLLED:

Farmers own, manage and decide what to do with their data.

FARMER DESIGNED:

Farmers nationwide helped build and test the ADC platform.

FARMERS FIRST:

Farmers are the primary focus of ADC's Founding Members.



WHO ARE THE USERS?



FARMERS:

Centralized, neutral, scalable and secure repository with data control, flexible sharing, and connections to clouds.

SERVICE PROVIDERS:

Data stored in grower accounts & shared with permission to ease data burden, improve service, and build trust.

UNIVERSITIES:

Centralized, permissioned data access encourages growers to collaborate in on-farm and regional research.
